Sailing Instructions Amendment No 1

- A) Sailing Instructions ADDENDUMS 1 and 2 are deleted and replaced by **ADDENDUM 1 AMENDED** and **ADDENDUM 2 AMENDED** respectively.
- B) Sailing Instructions 5, 6, 9 and 10 are deleted and replaced by Instructions 5, 6, 9 and 10 below:

5 COURSES, CLASS FLAGS AND STARTING ORDER

- 5.1 The diagram in **ADDENDUM 1 AMENDED** shows the approximate positions of courses 1, 2 and 3 in relation to False Bay Yacht Club.
- 5.2 The diagrams for Courses 1, 2 and 3, the allocation of classes to courses, and the various class flags and the courses to be sailed are all shown in **ADDENDUM 2 AMENDED**. The course symbol will be displayed on a black/whiteboard at the stern of the Signal boat no later than the warning signal for each class on each course.
- 5.3 The order in which classes start on each course will be as indicated by the Class Flag displayed at the Warning Signal. Competitors are reminded to watch for their class flag as the starting order might change from race to race

6 MARKS

All marks are described in ADDENDUM 2 AMENDED.

9 THE FINISH

- 9.1 Course 1: The finishing line will be between a staff displaying a blue flag on the signal vessel (same as start vessel) at the starboard end and the course side of the port-end finishing mark.
- 9.2 Courses 2 and 3: The finishing line will be between a staff displaying a blue flag on the separate finishing vessel and the course side of the nearby finishing mark.







10 SHORTENING COURSE

In addition to the provisions of RRS 32, the race committee may also signal a shortened course by displaying flag F with repeated sounds at a rounding mark or gate. On this signal boats shall round the mark or pass through the gate as required to sail the course, and thereafter proceed directly to the finishing line. This signal shall be made before the first boat reaches the mark or gate and shall continue to be made until all boats still racing have passed these marks. This changes RRS 32.

C) The following is added to Sailing Instructions **14 SAFETY REGULATIONS**:

14.3 [DP] TALLY SYSTEM

Each boat in the classes below will be issued with a Tally number at registration:


- Optimist
- Tera
- ILCA 4
- 29er
- 420

A Tally-board will be placed on the ground floor at FBYC. Competitors in these classes shall remove their boat's Tally from the Tally-board before launching and return their boat's Tally to the Tally-board within 20 minutes of returning to shore on each day. Failure to comply with this rule will result in a penalty.

Marks/Buoys: Rounding marks will be tall thin yellow pencil cylindrical inflatable buoys.


Starting and finishing marks will be small round red/pink buoys at the port end of line and the signal boat

(B) Start, 1,2,3,1,3,Finish

All rounding marks to be left to Port

Marks/Buoys: Rounding marks will be large cylindrical YELLOW inflatable buoys.

Starting and finishing marks will be small round red/pink buoys at the port end of line and the signal boat

at the starboard end of line.

Courses: (A) Start, 1,2,3,1,3,1,2,3,Finish

(B) Start, 1,2,3,1,3,Finish

All rounding marks to be left to Port

COURSE 3 – Hobie 16 & 29ers (Pennant 3)

Classes: - Hobie 16 Hobie Class flag

- 29er Class flag

Marks/Buoys: Rounding marks will be large cylindrical ORANGE inflatable buoys.

Starting and finishing marks will be small round red/pink buoys at the port end of line and the signal boat

at the starboard end of line.

Courses: To be displayed on the back of the committee boat

(6F) = Start, A, C, A, C, Finish

(6GF) = Start, A, C(gate), A, Cp, Finish

All rounding marks, except the gate, to be left to Port
